<p>Community Development Organization (CDO) \$100 (voting member)</p> <p>* CDAD CDO's receive the added benefit of becoming an automatic member of CEDAM (our state-wide sister organization).</p>	<p>A CDO (Community Development Organization) working in Detroit is an organization with these characteristics:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A place based non-profit, tax-exempt organization formed through local leadership; 2. Dedicated to a specific target area that is publicly known and not city-wide; 3. Governed primarily by the constituents served by the CDO; 4. Engaged in certain baseline activities (either directly or through collaboration and facilitation with other local organizations): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. <i>Community Organizing and Engagement,</i> B. <i>Land Use, Community or Economic Development Planning,</i> C. <i>Partnering/Facilitating, and</i> D. <i>Physical Development in some form, for example:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Housing</i> • <i>Commercial</i> • <i>Demolition and deconstruction</i> • <i>Public and/or recreation, such as streetscapes, community clean-ups, park development and maintenance, green/open space development, greenway development, land management.</i>
<p>Neighborhood Improvement Organization (NIO) \$100 (voting member)</p> <p>*NIOs who qualify for CEDAM Practitioner membership will receive free CEDAM reciprocal membership.</p>	<p>Other Neighborhood Improvement Organizations that support and/or partner with CDO's to improve the quality of life for residents and neighborhoods in the City of Detroit that do not meet the qualifications of a CDO. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialty Organizations • Social Change Organizations • Community Engagement Organizations • Human Development Organizations, such as Community Mental Health, Education, Health or Youth Organizations
<p>Community Groups \$25 (voting member)</p>	<p>Neighborhood-based organizations in Detroit. They are not formal 501c3 non-profits, are volunteer driven, and have little or no-funding or paid staff. The following types of organizations qualify:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Block Clubs • Neighborhood Associations • School-based Organizations
<p>Individual \$50 (non-voting member)</p>	<p>Persons involved in and committed to the goals of community-based economic development. If you are a Board Member of a voting member category listed above, or a qualified low-income individual, the cost is reduced (\$10).</p>
<p>Partners \$250 for entities with budgets under \$1 million; \$500 for entities with budgets over \$1 million (non-voting member)</p>	<p>Partners who are involved in and committed to the goals of community-based development; entities that either share our vision or partner with our Members. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Government • For-profit companies • Financial institutions • Intermediaries • Universities • Statewide organizations
